Detailed Dorm Information for Youth Camp 2015

I will start by saying, Albion camp has spoiled us in the last few years regarding this matter!

There is limited space in air-conditioned facilities at this location. The cafeteria area, craft area, and two dorm areas-- Wesley Lodge (male) and Asbury Lodge (female), are air conditioned. The other two main dorms Samuel Hall (male) and Susannah Hall (female) are not air conditioned. From personal experience, Samuel and Susannah may get warm during the day, but generally at night they are not uncomfortable at all. There are 6-8 screen doors and 12-16 windows that allow an adequate amount of air flow throughout the building. During the night, these rooms may even get brisk. A fan is highly recommended.

Wesley and Asbury sleep a maximum of 35 people each. These rooms will first be reserved for those who meet one of the following requirements: campers who are 40+, campers with small children (5 and under), and campers with medical necessity for a temperature controlled environment. Restrooms for these facilities (including showers) are attached and accessible from inside the lodge. Asbury sleeping rooms and restrooms can also be accessed from the cafeteria without going outdoors.

In addition to the sleeping quarters mentioned above, there are four cabins on the campus that will be used for those with *extensive* necessity for a controlled environment. Initially, these areas will be reserved for seniors and those with disabilities that may otherwise prevent them from attending. After those campers are accommodated, we will attempt to honor other requests in order of severity. All cabins are air conditioned and have a kitchen facility inside.

The summer dormitories (Samuel Hall and Susannah Hall) sleep 75 campers each in four sections of bunk beds. The bath house for these dorms is located a few steps outside the door. We would ask that the majority of the youth without special needs stay in this area. There is nothing like experiencing camp surrounded by your friends and church family!

We will not automatically place anyone in air conditioned areas. A request should be made (see attached sheet) to make our arrangements more accurate. Please list each member individually who would like to be placed in any of the special areas. Anyone not requesting a special dorm assignment will be defaultly placed in the appropriate summer dormitory (Samuel or Susannah).

The small sacrifice of losing air conditioning for some should be counteracted by the other amenities that this camp has (inground pool w/ diving board, lake, canoes, large caged basketball area, better playground equipment, porch swing congregating area, A/C craft area, etc)... More information and photos should be available soon after we preview the camp!
